# RUNNINGJENKINS

#### • Server:

- RAM (Jenkins is a hungry butler!)
- CPU (if jobs need it)
- Disk (don't fill the system disk!)

# RUNNINGJENKINS

- Monitor RAM, CPU, Disk
- Monitor jenkins service if RAM is limited
  - <u>enforce-jenkins-running.sh</u>

- Install Java.
- Install Jenkins.
- Done!

- CI for Jenkins (CI-ception!)
- Local or test Jenkins environment
  - You wouldn't develop a Drupal site in prod (*riiiight?*), so why would you develop your automation in prod?!
