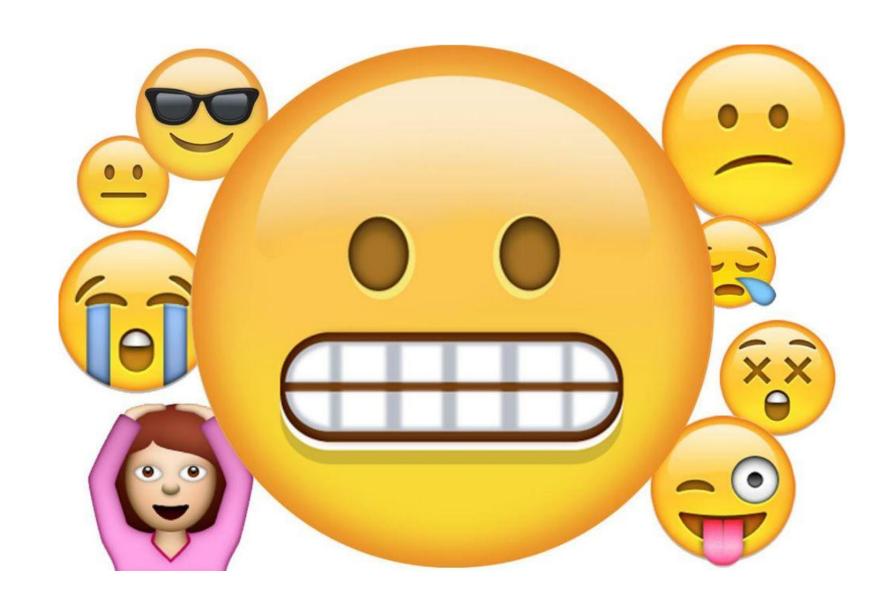

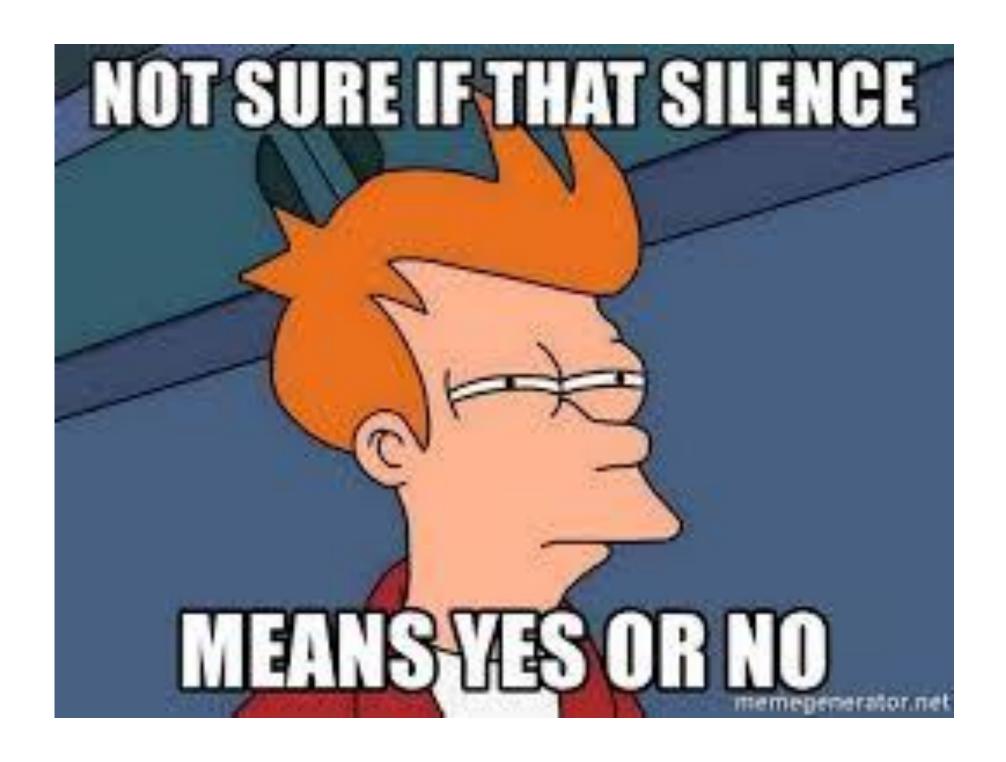
# Website projects have a range of emotions





## But if it's a bang or a whimper... it ends

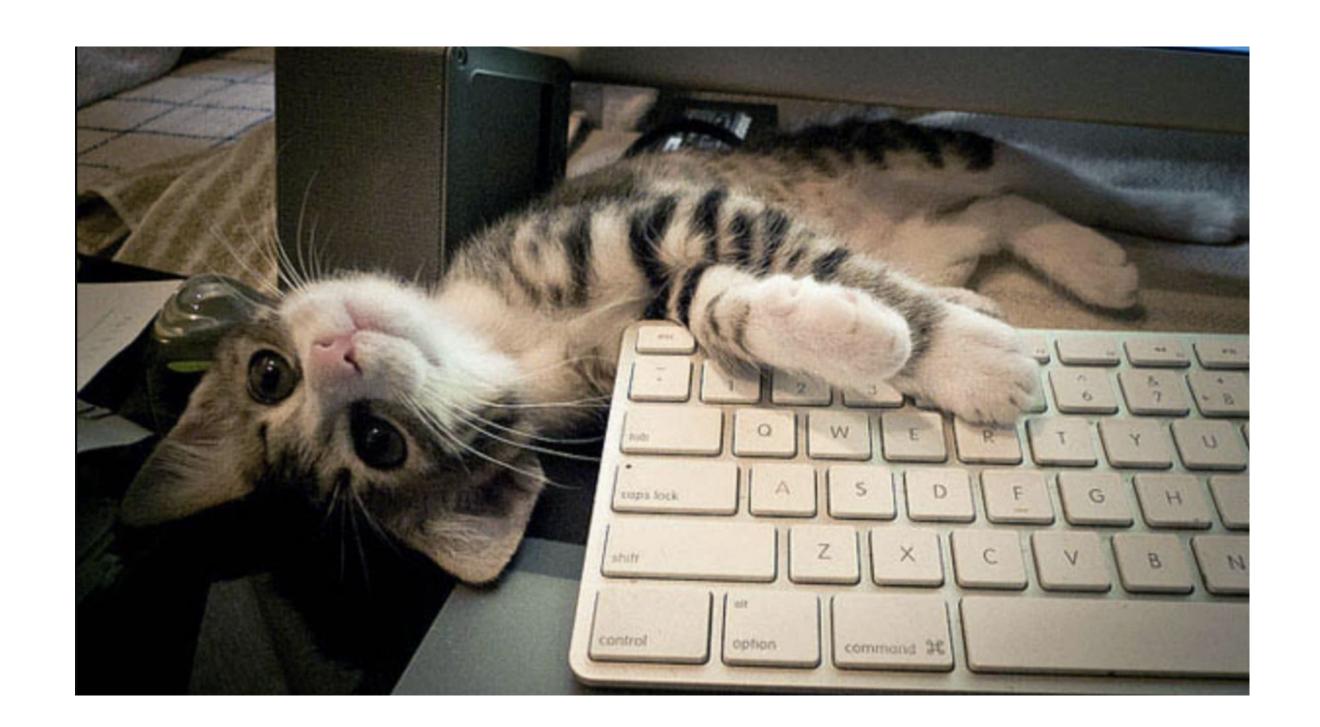
- Undone/post-launch items

   and they've moved on!





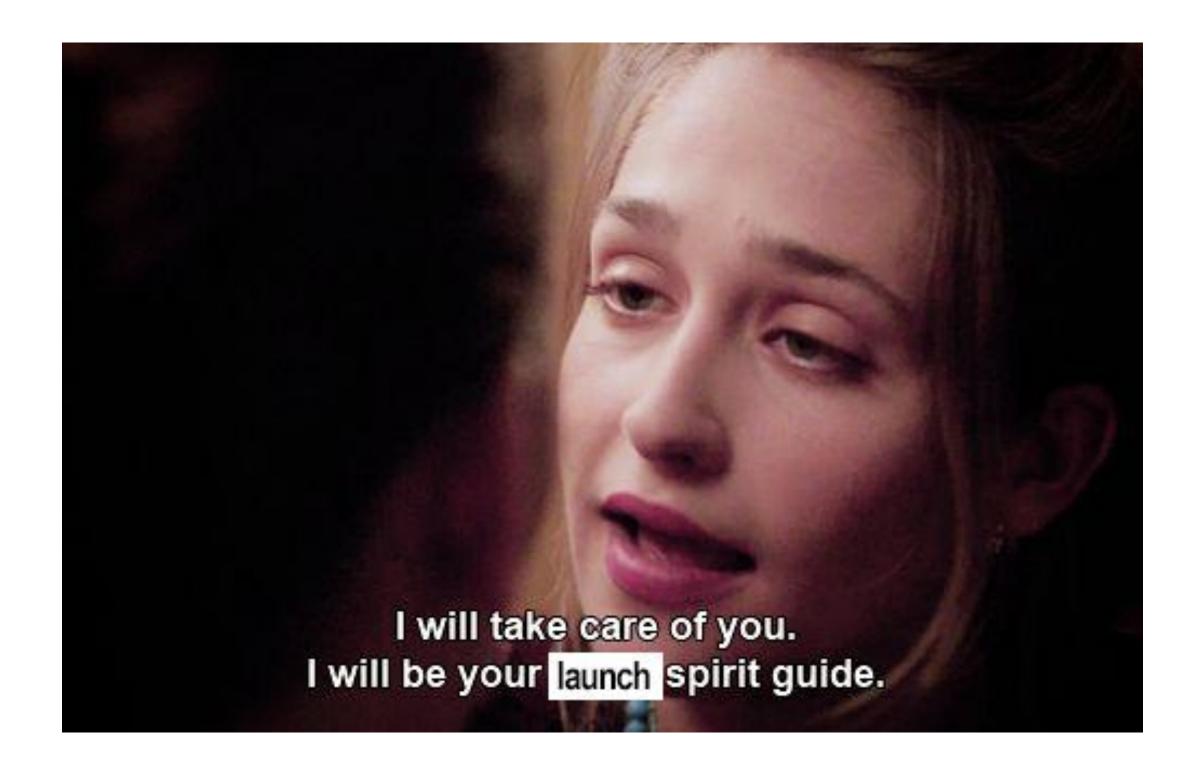

- Have clear markers/milestones

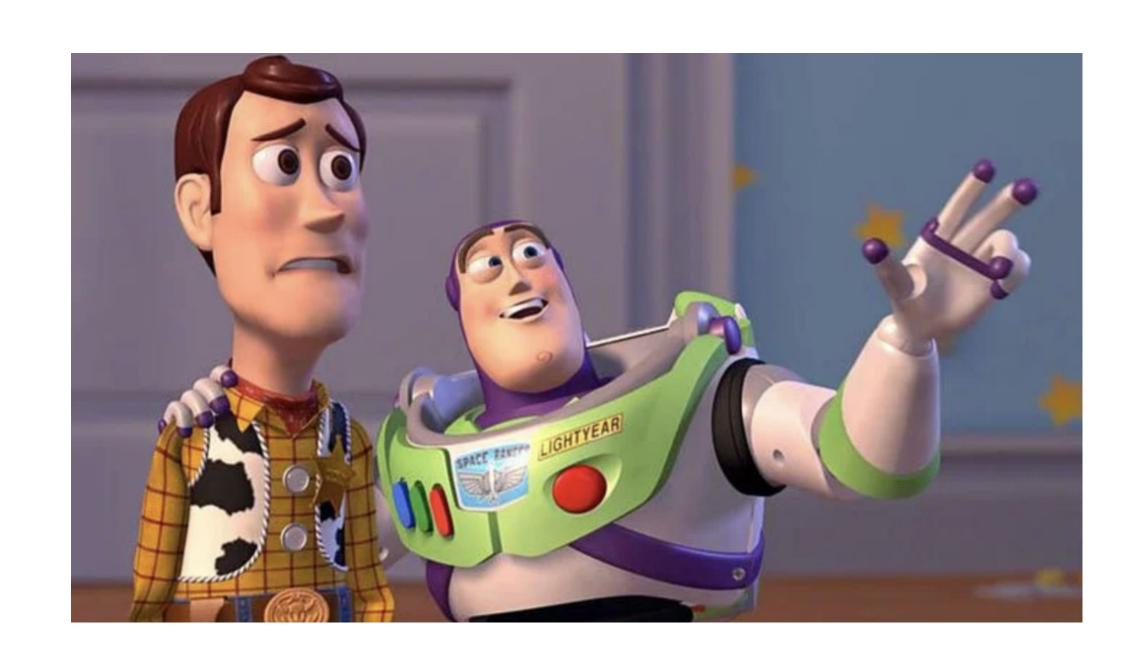


#### Plant the Seeds

- Google Analytics
- Search Term Tracking
- Plan for Maintenance



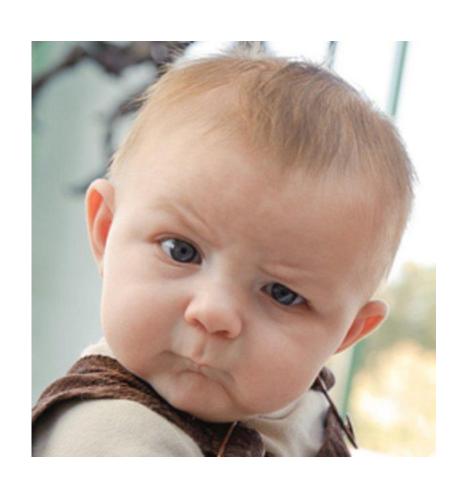
## Post-Launch: Security Updates (aka "The Talk")



- Make it not scary
- Don't wait until the first update comes out to talk about this
- And yes, talk about version updates too



## Ongoing Assistance: Clients Don't Know How You Can Help



- SEO
- Content strategy
- Content governance
- Editorial calendars



### Proactive Site Planning

- We know how to make sites better
- Mix the "boring" stuff with the exciting stuff



### **Budget Planning**

- Plan contacts around your client's fiscal year
- Operations vs Capital
- Accessibility audits
- Site speed audits
- Documentation/training updates
- Re-training
- Analytics
