### Machine Learning in GA4

### Analytics Intelligence

- Automated insights
  - Analytics Intelligence detects unusual changes or emerging trends in your data and notifies the user automatically
- Custom insights:
  - Customized conditions that detect important changes in data. When the conditions are triggered, the Insights are seen on the dashboard, and optionally through an email alert.

#### **Predictive Metrics**

Metrics to predict User Behaviour

- Purchase Probability
- Churn Probability
- Revenue Prediction

### **Anomaly Detection**

A statistical technique that Analytics Intelligence uses to identify anomalies in:

- Time-series data for a given metric
- Anomalies within a segment at the same point of time.

# Measuring Core Web Vitals with GA4

#### What are Core Web Vitals

- Set of performance metrics that focus on measuring the user experience of a webpage.
- Developed by Google
- Essential for gauging the quality of a website and can impact search engine rankings.
- The three main Core Web Vitals are <u>CLS</u>, <u>LCP</u>, <u>FID</u>

### Cumulative Layout Shift (CLS)

- Quantifies the unexpected layout shifts that occur during the loading of a webpage
- This metric is essential because sudden shifts in layout can be frustrating and disorienting for users, leading to a negative user experience
- A good CLS score should be under 100

### Largest Contentful Paint (LCP)

- Measures the time it takes for the largest visible content element on the screen to be *fully loaded and displayed*
- This metric is *crucial* because it gives an indication of the perceived loading speed of a webpage from a *user's perspective*
- A good LCP score should be under 2.5 seconds

### First Input Delay (FID)

- Measures the time between a user's first interaction with a page and the browser's response to that interaction.
- This metric is *reflects the responsiveness of a webpage* and can significantly impact the user experience
- A good FID score should be under 100 milliseconds






#### This module is becoming the **Google Tag**

module. The 2.0.x branch supports Google Tag and Google Tag Manager.

Currently the 2.0.x branch does not have a migration path from the 8.x-1.x branch for Google Tag Manager, but will by the release candidate phase.



This project integrates the site with the Google Tag Manager (GTM) application. GTM allows you to deploy analytics and measurement tag configurations from a web-based user interface (hosted by Google) instead of requiring administrative access to your website.

To use the module, sign up for GTM and obtain a "container ID" for your website. For development purposes, create a GTM environment for your website.

#### CRITICAL NOTES for releases 8.x-1.3+

If the site enables other modules that implement condition plugins (e.g. ctools, rules, webform), then it will most likely be necessary to apply the core patch from issue '3114467' (link intentionally omitted).

If Drush commands are run as a user other than the web user, then do NOT enable the **recreate snippets on cache rebuild** module setting unless the web user has permission to delete files created by the Drush user. This setting will be disabled by default beginning with release 8.x-1.6.



#### **Core Web Vitals Report**

Core Web Vitals are the subset of Web Vitals that apply to all web pages, should be measured by all site owners, and will be surfaced across all Google tools. The metrics that make up Core Web Vitals will evolve over time. The current set focuses on three aspects of the user experience-loading, interactivity, and visual stability-and includes the following metrics (and their respective thresholds):

- Largest Contentful Paint (LCP): measures loading performance. To provide a good user experience, LCP should occur within 2.5 seconds of when the page first starts loading.
- First Input Delay (FID): measures interactivity. To provide a good user experience, pages should have a FID of less than 100 milliseconds.
- Cumulative Layout Shift (CLS): measures visual stability. To provide a good user experience, pages should maintain a CLS of less than 0.1.
