## Why GitLab?


Improve our developer tools on Drupal.org

Login page will look slightly different, since it will be hosted by the 3rd-party







## GitLab CI: Replacing DrupalCI

We want to be feature-complete with DrupalCI

For core & contrib, Current Drupal & Legacy Drupal 7 **Provision containers** 

Assemble codebase with dependencies

Lint (php, css, es)

Run tests (PHP, JS, etc)


Report results

## GitLab CI

DrupalCI was centralized, GitLab CI is decentralized

GitLab CI replaces parts of DrupalCI that were cumbersome to maintain

## Issue #3218392: use yarn config for p



# GitLab CI: Actually running the tests

Every maintainer will have to set up their own .gitlab-ci.yml file, if they want testing

Replaces both the scheduling on Drupal.org and configuration that was implicit in DrupalCI

We want to find ways to make this transition easy for maintainers

We have templates in development


Project maintainers can now request GitLab CI and help improve those templates

# GitLab CI: Discontinuing .patch files

GitLab CI tests merge requests, not patches

When a project switches from DrupalCI to GitLab CI, patches won't be tested




After this change jsonapi now checks if an entity type supports version negotiation on those entities using the query parameter.




